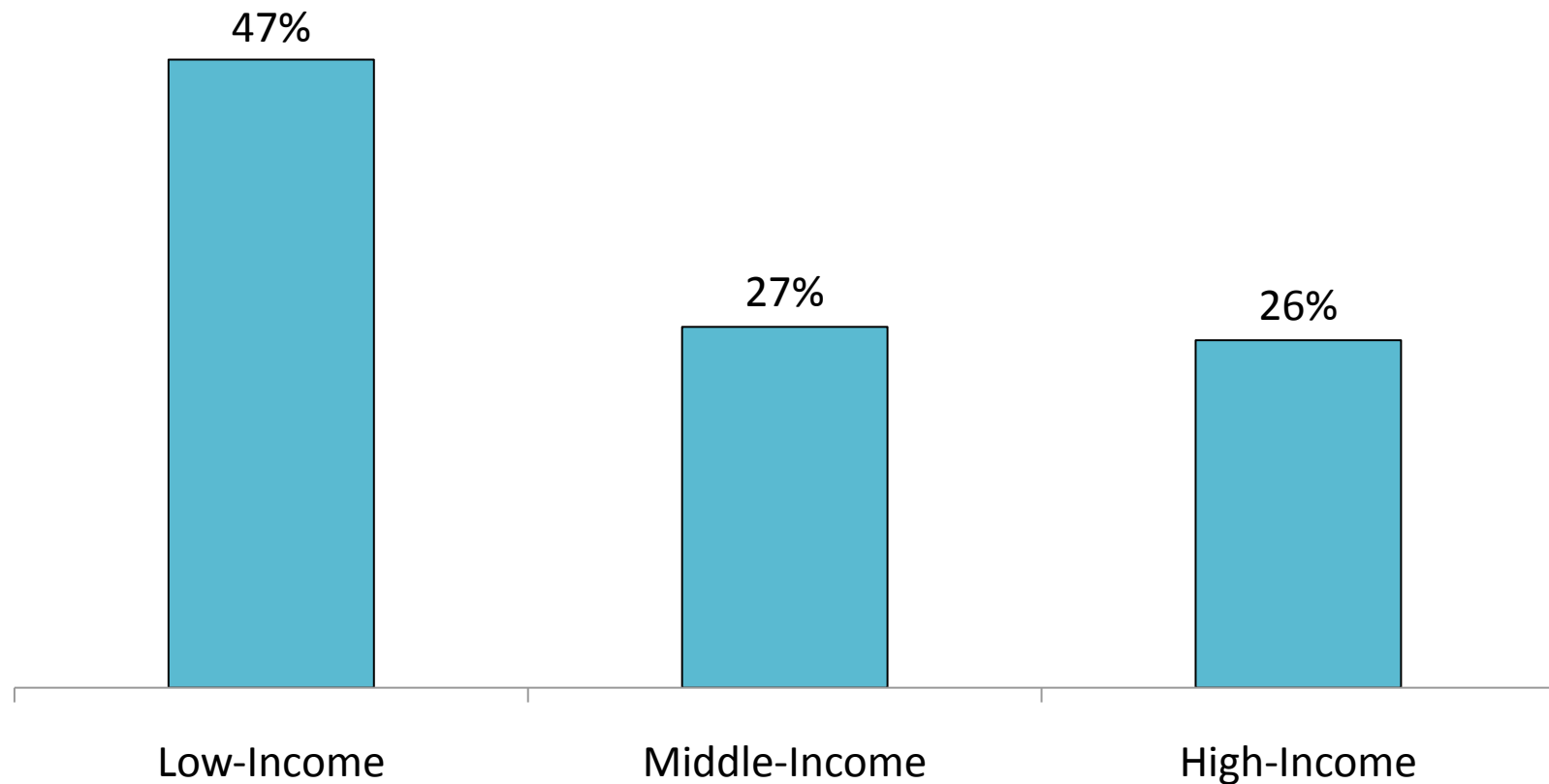
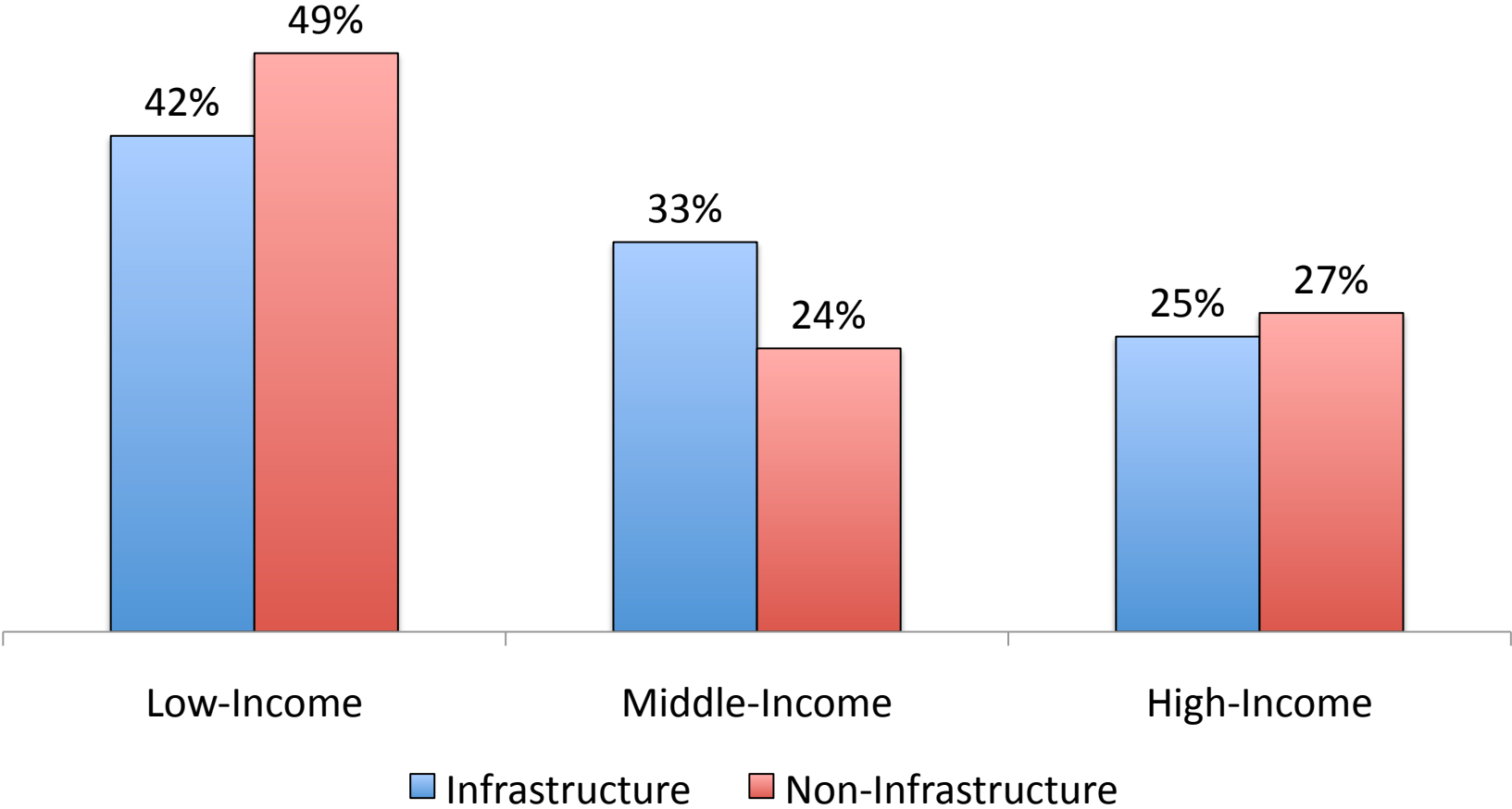


# Low-income schools received more Caltrans SRTS Cycle 3 grant awards than middle or high-income schools

# Summary of Caltrans Cycle 3 SRTS FRPM Data

- 831 California schools will benefit from Cycle 3 SRTS NI and I funding (816 public, 15 private)
- 47% of the grant awards went to low-income schools with 75% or more students eligible for Free and Reduced Price Meals
